COMMONWEALTH BASIC EDUCATION BOARD POLICY: STUDENTS' RIGHTS AND RIGHTS OF PARENTS/GUARDIANS OF STUDENTS UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE

All practices used by educational administrators to implement this policy must be in compliance with national, state, and applicable education laws and policies and protect the privacy, effectiveness and well-being of students that are under 18 years of age.

When a student with an enrollment request the registration of a previously the school, the student and all other appropriate personnel shall give the opportunity to explain the circumstances of the matter.

Students shall not be subjected to any practice for using a language other than English/Indonesian of a country. School administration or designee shall communicate with the student's parent/guardian when practices and facilities impact a student under the age of 18.

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES

Students to ensure that each student receives the treatment consistent with the standards requirements of law, process, student expectations and responses with accommodations for students shall be made in accordance with the following general rule:

Notice of Suspension to Students: The principal or designee shall deliver by hand or mail a copy of the written notice of the suspension (SUSPENSION) to the student within twenty-five (25) hours of suspension. Notice of the student to the school from written notice of the suspension shall not affect the ability of the suspension only after proceeding to court.

Notice of Suspension to parents/guardian of a minor student under 18: The principal or designee shall immediately attempt to notify the parent/guardian by telephone and shall thereafter the fact of such notice or attempted to provide notice.

The principal or designee shall follow by hand or mail copies of the written notice of the suspension to the student's school within twenty-five (25) hours of suspension.

The COMMONWEALTH administrative shall apply Policy 1000 (Suspension and Expulsion of Students) to students under 18 years of age.

Appeal of Suspension: The student or the parent/guardian of minor student is required to show process effectiveness referenced in the suspension process. The appeal shall be considered in the principal or designee acting prior to the resolution date of the suspension.

The principal or designee shall arrange a conference with the student or parent/guardian.

The conference will take place at the school site and is convened by the principal or designee. The principal or designee shall only be subject to process acting if the fact occurs within the 30 days of having the appeal.

Notice of the Suspension to court: The principal or designee shall submit a written Report of Student Suspension (RSP) to the Office of the Attorney General, Department of Education, including information of the suspension against the student and a detailed description of the incident with supporting documentation. The student will have the first hearing on the student's appeal.

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Abstract The purpose of this study was to examine the effects of a 6-week training program on the physical fitness and health-related quality of life (HRQL) of sedentary elderly people. A total of 70 elderly people were randomly assigned to either a control group or an exercise group. The exercise group performed a supervised aerobic and resistance training program three times per week for six weeks. Physical fitness parameters measured included maximum oxygen consumption ($\dot{V}O_{2\max}$), peak power output (PPO), and peak heart rate (HR). HRQL was assessed using the EuroQOL-5D questionnaire. After six weeks, the exercise group showed significant improvements in $\dot{V}O_{2\max}$, PPO, and HR compared to the control group. Additionally, the exercise group reported higher scores on the EuroQOL-5D questionnaire, indicating improved HRQL. These findings suggest that a structured exercise program can effectively improve physical fitness and HRQL in sedentary elderly individuals.
